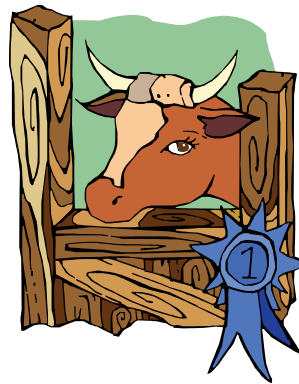

State Fair of Texas Entries Due August 19

If you are interested in exhibiting in the State Fair of Texas, you must enter by Friday August 19th. All market animals eligible for entry must have been validated in June.

State Sheep & Goat Validation Tag Orders Due

If you plan to exhibit a market lamb, market goat, or breeding sheep project in the Ft. Worth, San Antonio, San Angelo, Houston, or Austin Livestock Shows, you must be state validated. Tag orders are due to the Mills County Extension Office by Tuesday, August 30th. Cost is \$8.00 per tag for market lambs and goats and \$3.00 for breeding sheep. Validation will be held in October.
