Steer Validation Tag Orders


If you plan to exhibit a market lamb or goat at the State Fair of Texas in October, you must order state validation tags and validate your animal. Tag orders are due by Thursday, April 14th and will cost \$7.00 per tag. Validation will take place in June. 

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Horse Validation

All 4-H horse projects must be owned and validated on or before May 1st. This includes the appropriate paper work and a \$10.00 fee per horse. Each horse must be validated to show at the District 7 Horse Show in June. 

District 7 Jr./Intermediate Photography Contest

Anyone interested in competing in the District 7 4-H Photography Contest, must have their photos submitted by Friday, April 8th. All photos must have been taken after January 1, 2010.
